### CHIPPEWA VALLEY ELECTRIC COOPERATIVE ANNOUNCES AIR CONDITIONER CONTROL INCENTIVE

**L**oad management control is very important to the Co-operative and the members, since the co-op's costs are reflected in the rates per kilowatt hour.

We have come up with another way of saving you money and cutting down on the co-op's cost to purchase power during the peak times of summer.

If you are NOT on the dual fuel, off-peak heating program, but have a central air conditioning unit in your home, you can help lower the peak demand charges for the co-op

and receive a \$6 per month credit, just for allowing the co-op to install a load management receiver on your central air conditioning unit. There would be no cost to you for the installation of the load control receiver, we will install that. You could receive \$6 per month for the months of June, July, & August.

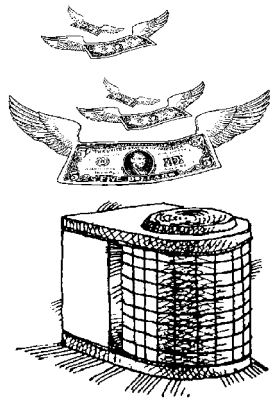
A load control receiver would be installed on the central air conditioner and the air conditioner will be controlled during peak times—15 minutes on/15 minutes off.

▶ Must be central air conditioner

- ▶ Air conditioner cannot be on any other program (hooked up on dual fuel meter)
- ▶ Control must be installed outside of building
- ▶ Agreement must be signed by member
- ▶ Member agrees to be on program minimum of two years
- ▶ \$6 credit only for the months of June, July, August

If you are interested in signing up for this program, please call us at 239-6800 or 1-800-300-6800 and request a form. We can mail it out to you for signature or stop into the office and sign one. We'll make an appointment and have our technician install the load control receiver.

If we all work together, we can make a difference in what our energy costs in the future, by controlling demand for power now.
