

This Giving Season, Consider Operation Round Up

Would you be willing to spend \$6 a year to do some good in your local community? Members of Chippewa Valley Electric Cooperative are invited to opt into our Operation Round Up program and do just that! Members who choose to participate "opt in" to have their electric bill rounded up to the next whole dollar each month. Those funds are then pooled into CVEC's Chippewa Valley Community Fund, which is used to support families and projects in CVEC's service area.

A committee of CVEC members oversees distribution of the funds, which in the past have been used to support families facing a serious illness, death in the family, house fires, or other hardships. In the spirit of the cooperative principle of "Concern for Community," the program also aims to make life better for members in the service territory by supporting causes within the community.

Other co-ops have created this program as an "opt out" option, meaning members were automatically enrolled and would need to opt out if they didn't want to participate; however, CVEC chose to let members decide if they wish to contribute. That said, now is the time to opt in if you want to participate and do some good right here in the community!

Of our 6,500 members, we have only 871 enrolled in Operation Round Up. We'd love to see that number hit 1,000 by the end of 2023! The more members we have enrolled, the more causes we can support!

Dual Fuel Heating Systems to Be Tested November 15

As the heating season fast approaches, we are preparing for another Wisconsin winter with a test of our load management system. From 7-11am on November 15, CVEC will test our load management system for members who participate in the dual fuel or off-peak heating program. Electric heat will be shut off at this time for members with back-up heating systems.

This test is a benefit for you as well as the cooperative. We want to make sure your backup heating system and the load control device work properly before we get into extremely cold weather. If you experience a problem during the test, contact your heating contractor. If there is an issue with your load management receiver or if you have questions, contact CVEC at 715-239-6800.
